Our Purpose

The Guidance Center is a unique program designed to serve all of the middle, intermediate and high schools in our district. The center is an off campus suspension center where students are assigned when they violate the Pasadena ISD code of conduct.

Our ultimate goal at the Guidance Center is to provide students with strategies and knowledge that allow them to be successful academically and behaviorally when they return to their home campuses. By closely collaborating with each student's home school, we are able to design individual support to help in completion of home school assignments. This enables students to stay on track academically while they are at the center and be prepared to return to their classroom.

In addition, our low student/teacher ratio and structured environment afford students the ability to catch up on work that they may be behind on and focus on weak areas in content subject areas. Our teachers also provide direct instruction in the core content areas and plan their lessons around the district's scope and sequence.

The center also focuses on providing students strategies to manage their behavior and to help them make better choices at their campus and in life. We do this by infusing character education into each class period and by utilizing our counseling program.

The counselor is able to provide group and individual counseling to the students that is not always readily available at their home school. Any student may see a counselor upon request, and each repeat student is required to do so.
